Extensive reading (ER) and constant reading (RR) are two types of reading instructions that have been used in English as a second or foreign language (ESL or EFL) as useful means of increasing reading fluency and understanding. ER is a method that allows readers to choose resources from a collection of books with the objective of reaching specific target times of silent sustained reading (Donnes, 1999; Hill, 1997)). ER is thought to increase L2 learners' fluency, i.e., their ability to automatically recognize an increasing number of words and phrases, an essential step to comprehension of L2 texts (Grabe, 1991; Paran, 1996; Perfetti, Van Dyke, and Hart, 2001).

Teachers should use different types of reading styles to improve EFL such as the intensive and extensive reading. Those two types are suitable for those who look to reach the upper levels of English language. Recording to ERICA FERRER KENDRA STALEY (2016) When designing a creative reading plan, one can consider two admired perspectives to teach reading in the EFL classroom, intensive and extensive reading. While intensive reading entails that "each text is read carefully and thoroughly for maximum comprehension" (Aebersold & Field, 1997, as cited in Hedgcock & Ferris, 2009, p. 161)

According to Alghamdi in reading skills, there are more specific criteria for each skill that conclude reading performance. For instant, counting how many words were read per minutes (WPM) is one way of evaluating the students' reading fluency (Young & Daly, 2016).

It's a good challenge that give a student's kind of enthusiastic that let him/her compete with his/her friends and then get a huge of vocabulary and enhance reading skills.

Using technology to improve reading skill

Technology can be beneficial in improving reading skill. The use of technology became a significant tool for learning in and out of the class. Ahmadi (2018) stated that technology has been used to help and develop language learning. He added by saying that technology allows teachers to adjust classroom activities that increase the language learning process. Intensive reading is the second goal that I am planning to achieve when I back to home school. In this goal I will provide a plan that increase students comprehension through reading a short stories. After


read these stories students should write a brief what he understand from this story and he should memorize the new vocabulary on it. I will apply this strategy once a week during the academic year.


